- 1 3" Binder
- 1 pkg. of 5 tab dividers
- 1 pkg. of clear sheet protectors (25 minimum)
- 2 pkgs. of college-ruled loose-leaf notebook paper*
- 1 pkg. of white copy paper
- 1 composition book (Marbleback is fine because we will personalize them)
- 3 college ruled single subject spiral notebooks
- 2 pkgs. of pencils*
- 1 pkg. of pencil top erasers
- 1 pink wedge eraser
- 1 hand held pencil sharpener (NOT battery operated)
- 2 black or blue ballpoint pens (NO Sharpies) *
- 2 red ballpoint pens (NO Sharpies)*

- 2 Ultra Fine Point Black Sharpies (Non-bleeding preferred)
- 2 black fine tip dry erase markers*
